Tardy Reduction Goals - Names given to Social Worker/Poirier - simple sticker chart - SUCCESSFUL!

Dibels Testing - Janae Lamb - Wall of success! Ranked by color and category. Tremendous progress.

100% Monthly Attendance Award - The program is working very well. Students are excited and aware. Wonderful response from students.

Human to human interaction has more weight than just content. The Board (McKay Jensen) commends us for the efforts being made.

ESP 100% visit - Wasatch Qualified Successfully. Included home visits where needed.

MTSS/DIBELS/PBIS PROGRESS REPORTS - Rene

Tremendous progress. The level of expectations have risen and is being recognized by the teachers and students.

Adding the new category (BLUE) makes the DIBELS scores better to read and share with parents about their students level.

Tripp 4th Grade - Dyad Reading - A program that has helped students add an average of 20-30 words per minute in their reading timings and fluency levels.

The end of the second term is a big turnover time.

Writing update - Professional Development with teacher on writing techniques to help teacher with programs and resources.

What do we do with students who are above level? Enrichment classes and other resources are being offered and other programs are being researched.

PBIS - Positive Behavior Intervention - Mrs. Paiva (life skills rm) keeping a report of types/grades/time/places/etc. when behavior is happening.

Higher offenders are in the lower grades and are happening in the afternoon.

Percentage split evenly between class and recess.

Some teachers have more offenders than others.

Specialty classes see a larger percent.

Math (multiplication) with the Principal and Vice Principal is a new program with 3rd and 4th grade. Seeing good results. Some students are so excited and zooming right ahead.
