All Grades:

To Prepare: COME PREPARED WITH ABOUT ONE MINUTE OF A SONG TO SING ACAPELLA.

- (Any song will do, we just want to hear your voice!)
- Also, be ready to LEARN A SIMPLE DANCE and perform it with the group.
- If you check the box on the form marked "Speaking Roles"
 I will ask you to READ SIDES in a group setting.
- As auditioners, I expect you to show Respectful Audience Behavior for those participating. There may be some downtime for you, so bring a book to read, or homework to do for those times when you are not actively working.

Parts:

Looking for:

- Each grade will have an ensemble of singer/dancers to perform their musical numbers.
- There will be 4 LEAD Speaking Roles. (Any grade.)
- Each grade will have featured CHARACTERS in each musical number
- Some featured characters will have singing SOLOS
- Some featured characters will have a small group DANCE FEATURE
- Some featured characters will have SPEAKING ROLES.

PARENTS: Please note, Not all students who audition will be cast.

If your child is cast in the show, we have to ask for a small fee of **\$15** to help pay for production costs. If this is a problem, please contact Jess Hansen at <u>jessicaje@provo.edu</u>. The cash or check will be due the <u>first</u> week of rehearsal.

Tech Week: (All cast & crew will be called to these rehearsals. No conflicts will be permitted on these days. Tech rehearsals will be held on the Stage.) Tuesday, November 5. Set Tech Thursday, November 7. Set Tech and Props Friday, November 8. Add costumes. Tuesday, November 12. Costumes, set tech, props. Thursday, November 14. Dress Rehearsal. Friday, November 15. Final Dress Rehearsal.

Rehearsals: Will be held on a rotating basis by grade level. See the attached calendar. The schedule is set through September. For October the rehearsal times are fixed, but which grade level will be called on which day is TBA.

 \rightarrow Leads and featured characters may be called on other days besides their scheduled grade level call. Please watch the calendar and note your child's schedule conflicts on the audition form.

Attendance Policy:

Actors and Crew will not be allowed to miss more than **1 grade level** Rehearsal and parents must inform the director if their student is going to miss. **Each grade level only has about 6 times to rehearse together so attendance is Crucial.** No conflicts for TECH WEEK rehearsals will be permitted.

A note: This is not a typical play or musical. This is a Musical Revue where we will perform numbers from many different shows and put them together under one big umbrella. Each grade level ensemble will have about two featured numbers they will perform on stage. The featured characters and soloists will be selected out of each grade level. The Leads may come from any grade level.

This show is designed to be able to cast as many kids as possible and get them up on the stage performing. For this particular show we will be accommodating many more students than a typical play can handle. As such, if you are a parent who would be willing to help facilitate children through the space, help with costumes, props, etc, and can commit to the Tech Week and Performance dates, WE NEED YOU! :D
